To develop this universe, the band created a mix of death and groove metal. Mixing together the brutality and the speed to create a massive punchy sound.





SELF-RECORDED EP




After a few months composing we began the process of recording the EP, using our own equipment and a few microphones that were kindly lent to us. Thanks to the relative affordability of hardware, we were able to do everything ourselves, as we have some experience in audio engineering and recording. After a few weeks of mixing and mastering and refining, we were proud enough to decide to release the EP.

On October 25th we release the EP on a few major streaming platforms through Distrokid. Later will we release a physical version of the record, as a CD.



LIVE EXPERIENCE



The main focus of the band is the live experience. From the moment we get on stage, everything is prepared and rehearsed, we aim for excellence. The lights and smoking machines are synchronized with the music, to control the atmosphere throughout the show.

The end goal is to transport the public with us in a self reflecting journey, while keeping some distance between us, this is a hostile environment.

Each member wears a dark green uniform, and a mask that covers the face. This is the uniform, each member is dressed identically to reinforce the distance between them and the public.

Most show last about half an hour, with tracks of varying intensity and dynamics, that is, it's always full blast.
